Healing Hands The Purpose of a Miracle

All of us love miracles! For some of us, a miracle is the only way out; we need a miracle. I often love to preach, saying if we serve a supernatural God, we must see supernatural things in our life! Our Lord has proven again and again that he is a miracle-working God. There is perhaps nobody in the Bible who used his healing hands more than Jesus. However, in Matthew 12:38, when the Pharisees asked Jesus for a miracle, we read that Jesus got angry at them. Why? because the Pharisees got the purpose of a miracle all wrong.

What is the purpose of a miracle? From our perspective, a miracle has a binary purpose, to help us, to heal us, to free us. But from our Lord's perspective, a miracle is much more than for improving our lives. He is the alpha and the omega, and from the perspective of eternity, the ultimate miracle even resurrection that Lazarus enjoyed was short-lived - Lazarus died again! Jesus's admonition of the Pharisees gives us a glimpse into the divine purposes of a miracle.

Firstly, the Lord expects a response from us after a miracle. The miracle needs to lead us to repentance. The miracle must start a new hunger in us - hunger for the word of God, hunger to pray more, hunger to work for God. Simply put, it must make us move! Jesus compares this movement to that of the Queen of Sheba, who traveled all the way from the ends of the earth to listen to Solomon's wisdom (Matt 12:42). How much more should we respond to a miracle from the one far greater than Solomon? Have we forgotten the miracles that the Lord has done for us? What were our responses to these miracles? Have we moved for God in addition to the norm? Have any of these miracles gone in vain in us?



explains the lifespan of a miracle using a parable (Matt 12:43-45). In the parable, we read about a man possessed with an impure spirit, which was cast out. The miracle resulted in a clean heart, swept in order. Simply put, the person who was once mentally unstable now became sane, his debt cleared, his wedding perhaps done, he got a new job and house as a result, and he started living a blessed life. But then we read that because of his lack of response toward God, the evil spirit came back, and this time his condition became seven times worse than before. For that man, the miracle was a transaction with God, but for God, the miracle was the of beginning of a transformation in him. Our Lord expects every miracle to begin a transformation in us that will last a lifetime. Are miracles continuing to transform us?

The lifespan of a miracle can be vividly seen in the lives of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in Daniel-3. All three become governors in the land because of a miracle God performed through Daniel, but now because of the same miracle, they were condemned to be burnt in the fire. I can only imagine what they were thinking as they were led to the furnace heated seven times over. I am certain they did not think that the first miracle was a mistake, but on the contrary, they knew the first miracle was the beginning of the act of God, and the lifespan of the miracle was still ongoing in their lives. God wasn't done with them but had only begun his work in them.

We all know how it ended - they not only overcame the fire miraculously but also got promoted, this time not because of Daniel's recommendation but for their own merit. The miracle that started with Daniel took a while to come to fruition. I pray that the Lord who started his good work in us will continue transforming us until the full measure is reached.

I am a native of Kumbanad, Pathanamthitta district of Kerala, and was profitably running a financial institution since 1993. From 2003 onwards, due to various reasons, I couldn't sleep and was in a very desperate situation. I visited all famous pilgrimage centers with offerings for peace of mind, but it was in vain. My situation becomes worse every day. I was in fear of death.

Then I learned about the deliverance meeting conducted by **Pastor P R. Baby** every second Saturday in my hometown at Kumbanad YMCA hall, which is very near to my home. I had attended a meeting, and on the very first meeting, I felt that GOD was speaking to me directly and touched the problems I was undergoing. That night, after a long time, I slept peacefully. I felt a divine peace inside me. Then I started attending Faithcity church's Sunday worship service regularly, and GOD solved all my problems.

My house was under construction, I couldn't finish the work, and it was kept pending for a few years. When I shared the matter with Pastor P. R. Baby, he told me that he would come and pray at my construction site. When he came to the construction site for prayer, the gate of the house was locked with Godrej seven lever lock. When I tried to open the lock, the key broke inside the lock and it was impossible to unlock. When the pastor saw this, he just prayed touching the lock and to my surprise, the lock opened by itself with the broken piece of the key inside. The yearlong bondage was broken, and I could complete my construction, conducted three days of prayer meetings on the premises, and started living in the house from 2004 October onwards. The Financial institution I was running profitably for the past 15 years was liquidated in October 2008 by paying all my dues and liabilities.

By the grace of God, On July 25th Morning, the New Testament Audio Bible in Garo language was released by Mr. Rakkam A. Sangama, Education minister of Meghalaya, who is also from the Garo tribe. In his inaugural speech he said the audio Bible in the

Garo language will be a life changer for his comm The project for recording Garo bible is led by Bro. Kurien Fenn, whose great grandfather, Mr. Chandhu Menon (1778-1837), a Hindu by birth is credited with helping translate the Bible from English to Malayalam. Mr. Menon, an expert in English, Malayalam, and Sanskrit, met Rev. Benjamin Bailly while working as the they Tahsildar of Kottayam. Together translated the Bible to Malayalam and completed the work in 1819.

I'm honoured and humbled as this was my first practice as a Registered Medical Practioner. But few days prior to the trip, my husband fell and broke his arm. My Passion for Mission Field

Working in a mission field was always a passion for me. But I was not aware of how to go about it. There were announcements in church about the mission work in Meghalaya and I was pretty excited about it. reached Meghalaya in the team led by Pastor Giby Raphael. The first day was a school health check-up, where we doctors(group of 4) examined and prescribed medicines for children from kindergarten to High-school (LKG – 10th std). A health check up and visiting a doctor were a distant dream to them. I also realized how blessed I am and how we can be a blessing to others. We attended prayer groups in the village, where I saw people worshipping God with all their hearts.

The next day we went to another village to do a health camp. We examined people and gave medicines. Most haven't even seen a doctor or checked their vitals (like BP, Blood sugar), in their lives. Lots had nutritional deficiencies. I realized how much luxury we live in. There were hardly any hospitals on the way, so we traveled back and forth, hundreds and thousands of kilometers in Meghalaya.



Simsang River is a major river in the Garo Hills of Meghalaya and Netrakona District of Bangladesh. It divides the Garo Hills into two parts. The river starts from Nokrek Peak and runs towards the east, passing through Rongrengiri, Williamnagar, the headquarters of East Garo Hills district, Nongalbibra, Siju, Rewak and Baghmara, the headquarters of South Garo Hills district and finally flows to Bangladesh.
