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He was an Indian politician who was the Governor of Manipur, from 27 June 2019 to 23 July 2019 and Governor of Nagaland, from 19 July 2014 to 31 July 2019, also Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, from 28 January 2017 to 3 October 2017 and Governor of Tripura, from 21 July 2014 to 19 May 2015.

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SALMON is a peculiar fish that exhibits what scientists call anadromous migration. It is born in freshwater but then migrates to salt water in the ocean to grow and mature. After living in the ocean for up to five years and traveling thousands of miles, it does something that baffles scientists even today. The fish traces its way back; some say via magnetic orientation or others using smell to where it was born. Remarkably, it swims against the flow, i.e., upstream hundreds of miles to reach the spawning grounds. The journey is so arduous, and its passion and commitment so urgent that many will give up their lives out of exhaustion after reaching the destination and after spawning the next generation.

The salmon teaches us many important life lessons. While dead fish move with the flow, to create lasting value, leave a legacy, and accomplish great things, one needs to swim against the flow. This is not unlike what our master Jesus taught us. In Mark 8:31-33, Jesus began to speak about the great thing he was about to accomplish "plainly." Until then, the disciples were having a great time with Jesus; they were the people of the moment, crowds followed them everywhere, there was magic in the air, and life was good. But when Jesus started talking about suffering, rejection, and death on the cross, the disciple's expectations visibly revolted. Peter was the spokesperson as usual, but knowing others were thinking the same, Jesus publicly admonished Peter. By then, their imagination had already gotten the better of them – to recapture the Jewish inheritance from the Romans and to reign in Jesus's cabinet. They had gotten so used to the fame and the attention that now they couldn't live without them. What is our attachment to fame and attention? Does that overshadow our attachment to Jesus? Jesus used their response to teach them the five behaviors that are needed to accomplish great things in life (Mark 8:34-38).

1 DENY YOURSELF

Life is a matter of choices, and every choice you make makes you – says John Maxwell. Accomplishing great things involves making tradeoffs, or in other words, one needs to give up to grow up. When the Lord led Israelites through the desert to the promised land, he was adamant that they be holy, and that meant being separated for God. There were many things that they couldn't do that others around them could. God commanded them to make the right choices through laws and to live a life of trade-offs. What are we willing to give up to grow up?

2 CARRY OUR CROSS

Hard work is the passport to success; simply put, there is no shortcut and we need to expense some calories to drag the cross.

3 FOLLOW JESUS

When following a car on the road, one needs to

always keep the car in sight. We need to keep Jesus in sight to follow him, hence the importance of praying, reading and meditating on the word of God daily, going to church every week, and not missing the fellowship of God's children. Each of these puts Jesus in our sight.

While the above three behaviors will get us very close to our purpose, Jesus talks about another important behavior that is needed to execute our purpose—the attitude of losing one's life to gain it, i.e., the behavior of taking risks. In Joshua 3, the Lord instructed the Israelites to overcome the overflowing and scary Jordan, the last obstruction, before setting foot on the promised land. The Lord asked them to carry the ark and, equally importantly, to step into the scary and overflowing river. He did not make it easy by stopping the flow, but he wanted them to step in first, in faith, to stop the flow. Risk-taking by faith and not by sight pleases God, and he is faithful to back us up.

God has called each one of us to accomplish great things in life. Through His life, Jesus showed us how to leave a legacy. It is human to resist change; it is natural to swim with the flow, but according to Jesus, to accomplish great things, we need to fight our natural tendencies and swim against the flow. I pray that the Lord will help us practice these five behaviors to fulfill the purpose for which he has called us and accomplish great things for him.


5 GIVE PRAISE



BUILDING A BRIGHTER FUTURE THE ROLE OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT IN EDUCATION

India needs more skilled workers, with only a small percentage of the workforce having undergone formal skill training. The country's focus is on scaling up skill training efforts to meet employer demands and drive economic growth. With a young population, India aims to provide a skilled workforce to address the expected shortfall in aging developed countries. The Skill development program aims to provide market-relevant training for the youth, create opportunities for talent development, and promote sustainable employment and entrepreneurship programs. ITI courses offer a variety of specializations for students after 10th and 12th, focusing on hands-on technical training for skilled trades that require experience-based skills and knowledge. These careers offer entry-level professionals the opportunity to join the workforce faster than traditional college education paths.

Technical training, also known as vocational training, is a way for professionals in skilled trade careers to learn essential skills for their jobs. This training can take place in a short education program, on-the-job training, or a combination of both. Professionals may advance through different levels of expertise, such as from apprentice to journeyman. Technical training focuses on developing hard skills and often involves hands-on learning. Various types of technical training programs can help you begin a career as a skilled tradesperson.

Agriculture trades involve studying farming and natural landmarks to produce food and protect the environment. Professionals in this field may focus on growing plants, caring for animals, or leading conservation efforts. Training can be done through KVKs and agricultural universities. Some careers in this trade include farm manager, equipment operator, animal caretaker, conservation technician, greenhouse manager, and precision specialist. Each of these roles involves managing different aspects of farming and conservation to ensure efficient and sustainable practices.

Construction trades involve the study of specific building materials and techniques, with professionals collaborating to build and renovate structures. Common construction careers include mason, carpenter, electrician, plumber, and heating/cooling technician. Masons work with brick and stone, carpenters with wood for walls and furniture, electricians manage wiring and lighting, plumbers handle water systems, and heating/cooling technicians install and repair climate control appliances. Technical training programs are available for these careers.

Like in construction trades, professionals in the art industry often specialize in specific mediums or tools. They are highly creative and may sell their work. Careers in this field include painters who work in construction or create art on canvas, ceramists who sculpt pottery out of clay, sculptors who work with various materials to create statues and figurines, and photographers who capture and edit photos for clients, often at events like weddings and concerts.

Technical training for manufacturing trade careers includes product creation and machinery usage. Some careers that require technical training in manufacturing include tool and die maker, machinist, and fabricator. Tool and die makers create precision tools, machinists use blueprints and computer software to create parts, and fabricators combine materials to make new creations and supplies for manufacturers. Transportation trade jobs involve operating and repairing specialized vehicles like trains, planes, buses, and heavy machinery. As they are responsible for the safety of passengers, professionals in these roles receive technical training to enhance their skills. Some transportation trade jobs include pilots who operate aircraft, bus drivers who transport passengers, train operators who ensure safe transportation, and heavy equipment technicians who service and repair machinery. Service trade jobs include careers that focus on providing customers a specific service or product. Examples of these jobs include hairdresser, baker, nursing assistant, and chef, all requiring technical training. Hairdressers cut, style, color, and wash hair, bakers create pastries and desserts, nursing assistants help patients with daily tasks, and chefs prepare food in restaurants and kitchens. Candidates should consider their interests and demands when choosing a skilled trade. KUMBANAD INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY


