Those incredibly privileged to live in this world with Jesus know that we cannot even think about living any other way. Jesus protects us, provides for us, comforts us, and takes care of us, but that perhaps is the same sales pitch that any other god may give.

However, two specialties of Jesus make him distinct:

- more for the benefit of you and me than Jesus.
- followers more about eternal life than Jesus.

The Bible clearly states that we cannot enter eternal life (heaven) by doing good works (Isaiah 64:6) - our works are like dirty rags in front of the Holy God. Jesus is the only way to eternal life (John 14:6). The sacrifice of Jesus on the cross changed the rules to enter heaven. The Bible says that if we confess, God will forgive our sins, and the faith in Jesus is credited as righteousness necessary to enter heaven (Romans 10:9). God changed the rules and we better be aware. Simply put - assume it is a test; to enter heaven, one must score 100 points. Our best works will get us 10 points before God, but right when we thought we would not make it, God introduced an extra credit worth 100 points for people who believed in Jesus while alive, giving us a total score of 110 points and making us more than qualified to enter heaven and dwell with him. I pray that we all claim this extra credit before it is too late, i.e., while we are alive. Confessing our sins and believing in Jesus is a required criterion to achieve eternal life, but the Bible says there is another expectation from God that we often take for granted.

Matthew 7:21 says it is not the people who call Jesus God who will enter the kingdom of heaven but the people who do the will of God. The prerequisite to do God's will is to surrender our will (body and mind) to God. Many of us have no issues surrendering our bodies, i.e., we don't steal, murder, or cheat, but surrendering our minds is hard. Romans 12:2 says that unless our mind is renewed and transformed, we may not even recognize the will of God. 1) There is no other god who has suffered and given up Where are we with surrendering our mind, including our thoughts, along with its fears and anxieties, to God?


2) There is no other god who has spoken and assured his Abraham is celebrated in the Bible for his obedience, for doing the will of God, which was credited to him as The full life on this earth is 70 to 90 years. I thank Jesus righteousness, but before he obeyed, he surrendered. for giving us hope beyond our short years on earth, for When God asked Abraham to leave his relatives, place, eternity, to dwell with him forever. If you are missing this profession, and legacy, God taught him to surrender his hope, I pray that you submit your life and accept Jesus as past. Later, Abraham surrendered his ambitions and goals when Lot moved out to the fertile land watered by Jordan, leaving Abraham the barren desert. God assured Abraham that God would be his inheritance, and God taught Abraham to surrender his future. Abraham's ultimate surrender came with his most treasured possession - his son Isaac. Abraham waited 25 years to receive his promise, the birth of his son Isaac, and during those years, God taught Abraham "not to give up." Later, when God asked Abraham to sacrifice Isaac, God taught him "to give up." In everything, Abraham obeyed God in faith without questioning, but before he obeyed, he surrendered his past, present, and future to God, which led him to see and approve the will of God.

I pray that the Lord will give us a daily practice of surrendering to Him. If there are worries of the past, fears of the future, including inadequacies and insecurities of the present, let's take a moment to surrender them all to God so that we can understand and obey God's perfect will for us. Let's pray -Lord, not my will, but yours be done.

Bridging the Educational Divide



Garo Hills has long been notorious for its abysmal pass rates in both the SSLC and HSSLC exams. Many have pondered the cause behind this issue, and one of the main factors seems to be the inadequate learning infrastructure at the lower primary level.

Non-formal education refers to educational activities that take place outside the traditional school system. It encompasses a wide range of initiatives within the community, including home-based learning, government programs, and community-driven projects. These initiatives can be accredited courses offered by established institutions or locally-run operations with limited funding. Non-formal education (NFE) serves as a strategy to provide elementary education to children between the ages of 6 and 14 who have been excluded from the formal education system due to various socio-economic constraints. The Centrally Sponsored NFE Scheme, launched in 1979-80, aims to establish NFE centers in villages without schools or with a high number of school dropouts.

While non-formal education encompasses various aspects, it shares similarities with lifelong learning. However, for the purpose of these guidelines, the focus is on non-formal education for children and young people who are not part of the regular school system. Although non-formal education is often seen as a second-best option compared to formal schooling, it is important to note that it can provide a higher quality of education than what is available in traditional schools. Non-formal education can serve as a preparatory, supplementary, or even an excellent alternative to formal schooling for all children.

The P.R. Baby Foundation aims to address the educational needs of the community by establishing this NFE Centre. We understand the difficulties faced by families in accessing quality education for their children in this area. By providing a dedicated facility in Moradum, we hope to bridge this gap and empower the children with the knowledge and skills necessary for their future success.

The NFE Centre will serve as a hub for educational activities, offering a range of programs tailored to the needs of the community. Our team of qualified educators will deliver engaging and interactive lessons, ensuring that each child receives personalized attention and support. We believe that education is a fundamental right, and through this initiative, we strive to make it accessible to every child in the region.

The remote village of Moradum in the South Garo Hills region presents a unique opportunity for the establishment of the NFE Centre. By utilizing the existing infrastructure, we can minimize costs and expedite the implementation process. Additionally, the support of the local congregation in Rongrengpal is invaluable, as their involvement will foster a sense of community ownership and sustainability.

A new Non-Formal Education Centre (NFE) has been established in the remote village of Moradum, located in the South Garo Hill district. This village lacks basic facilities and transportation options, making survival a challenge for its residents. The villagers have longed to provide their children with a basic education, and their dream has finally come true. On 08/03/2023, Dr. Giby Raphael and a team from Faithcity church visited Moradum village. The villagers expressed their desire for educational facilities for their children, who had not yet received any formal education. In response, we made a promise to prioritize the provision of educational resources.

On 28/07/2023, a new shed was constructed as a common facility center. It serves as a place of worship on Sundays and transforms into a school for the children during the rest of the week. This facility, named GEMS (Gasa English Medium School) Extension, was inaugurated on 13/02/2024, fulfilling our promise to the villagers.

Dr. Giby Rahael, Associate Pastor of Faithcity Church, Kochi, dedicated the center to the Glory of God. Dr. Amee Thomas inaugurated the initiative by roll-calling each student by name. On the inaugural day, 17 students were enrolled. Currently, the enrollment has reached 39 for this academic year. Mr. Rangsil Ch Sangma serves as the teacher, with Ms. Relina R Sangma as the assistant, Pr. Hardingson A Sangma as the principal, and Pr. Hebilson R Marak as the director. Together, they are committed to ensuring the smooth operation of the school.
